



Dementia Care and Support Navigation Program

The Dementia Care and Support Navigation program, supported by Dignity Health Community Grants, is a partnership between Dignity Health providers, the Alzheimer's Association®, Del Oro Caregiver Resource Center and Rebuilding Together.

The goal is to support families impacted by Mild Cognitive Impairment, Alzheimer's or other forms of dementia through disease education, support, respite care, and/or home safety assessment/modifications.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Any patient or family member impacted by Mild Cognitive Impairment, Alzheimer's or other forms of dementia.

SERVICES:

The program will connect patients and families to a network of community agencies for support.

Alzheimer's Association 24/7 Helpline, care consultation, disease education, support groups (early stage and caregiver), access to MedicAlert® + Alzheimer's Association Safe Return® (24-hour nationwide emergency response service for those who wander) and more.

DEL ORO CAREGIVER RESOURCE CENTER

Family consultation/case management services, respite care, short-term caregiver counseling, legal and financial consultation and education.

REBUILDING TOGETHER

Home safety assessments for minor home safety modification and minor home energy improvements.
