Program Overview: *Safe at Home* services help older adults and people with disabilities prepare and maintain the home they love. The services include simple adaptations that improve the recipient’s safety, mobility and independence.

Safe at Home is provided for no-cost to qualified low-income recipients. The services are available for a reasonable fee to those who don’t meet the low-income qualifications. Proceeds from the fee-based services help to fund the no-cost activities.

Job Description: Volunteer Installers are responsible for installing safety devices and performing simple home repairs/maintenance. The type of work includes:

- Grab bars in bathrooms
- Handrails and stair modifications
- Wheelchair/walker ramps or steps
- Raised toilet seats
- Nightlights, smoke, fire and carbon monoxide detectors
- Shower seats, bath mats, hoses
- Minor repairs

Time commitment: *Safe at Home* jobs occur Tuesday and Thursday mornings. Volunteers can work one or both days. They meet at 7:30 a.m. at the RTS office for a quick meeting and to gather supplies. The teams of two leave the office at 8:00 and are typically back by 11:00.

Qualifications: Volunteers should be polite and courteous with a passion for making a difference in the lives of others. Prior experience with home maintenance and light carpentry is a plus, but not required. Installers must submit the volunteer application, volunteer waiver, and complete a training process. A background check is also performed.

Support Provided: Rebuilding Together Sacramento will provide the tools and supplies to successfully complete the job.
