



Safe at Home Installer
Job Description
Temporary, Part-Time Position

Program Description: This is a rewarding position helping older adults and those with disabilities live safely at home. The employee will work alone or in a team to install accessibility and energy-saving items such as grab bars in showers and stair handrails, aluminum wheelchair ramps, mobile home steps, lightbulbs, portable air conditioners or heaters, fans, power strips, and more.

Responsibilities: This employee will schedule appointments, coordinate supplies, perform installations, deliver items, and complete paperwork.

Time Commitment

- Perform work in an average of 8-10 homes per week
- 30 hours per week
- We expect this position to be available for approximately 3 months but job performance, workload, and funding may extend employment.

Qualifications

- Skilled at using a drill and minor “handy” skills (Training is provided for specific installation skills related to the safety item.)
- Ability to work in under-served neighborhoods with older adults and people with disabilities
- Availability to work between Monday- Friday
- At least 21 years of age
- Bi-lingual is desired

Compensation: \$19.00 - \$21.00 per hour (depending on experience) and mileage reimbursement at .575 per mile. Mileage and hours are calculated from the RTS office. Sick leave is provided for this position but no other benefits.

A vehicle will be available, but there may be times when the employee must drive their own vehicle. The employee must provide a copy of the driver’s license and auto insurance information. A background check will be performed before employment can begin.
